



Microfiber Care Instruction



Laundry Guide



- Use warm water for washing.
- Refrain from washing the microfiber cloths with garments made of cotton or terry cloth.
- Avoid the use of fabric softener, bleach, or dryer sheets.
- If using a dryer, opt for a heat-free setting and exclude the use of dryer sheets.

In case heat is necessary, ensure that the drying temperature does not exceed 140°F (60°C). However, air drying is highly recommended as it facilitates quick drying of the cloths.

- Microfiber cloths possess the potential to endure up to 500 wash cycles.
